A member of Northwell Health, Southside Hospital is a 341-bed tertiary hospital, located in Bay Shore, which has been in existence for over 100 years and has become an important part of the community. We have renowned centers of excellence in cardiology, orthopedics, neuroscience and women's health services. Southside Hospital has a full-service surgical trauma team, a hospitalist program, specialty specific intensive care units, and numerous tertiary care programs.

About the Department:

As a designated tertiary care center, we care for the most complicated cases as well as routine emergency and urgent care patients. Services include:

- ACS Level II Verified Trauma Center: Our trauma center has dedicated in-house trauma surgeons 24/7. The ED and acute care surgeons share a collegial mission to provide the best trauma care.
- Stroke Center: Our Stroke Center is certified by the State of New York. The Stroke Center was awarded the Get With the Guidelines–Stroke Gold Plus Quality Achievement Award from the American Heart Association/American Stroke Association and Target: Stroke Elite Plus Honor Roll. The ED utilizes tele-neurology services, with SkyHealth for patients needing intravascular intervention for acute strokes.
- Emergency PCI Techniques for Treating Heart Attacks: Our cardiac care center is capable of performing all levels of service for coronary interventions. The ED also boasts the use of the LifeNet System for pre-hospital notification of STEMI patients, for which we received a Bronze Plus for Lifenet from AHA.
- Open Heart Surgery Center: Our advanced surgical capabilities allow us to care for the most critically ill and injured cardiac and chest patients without having to transfer patients to other facilities.
- Split-Flow Model of Care: The Split-Flow Model of Care is an evidence-based best practice that has been adapted by Southside's Emergency Medicine Department with the goal of shortening the time before a patient is seen by a provider, as well as the overall length of time spent in an emergency department visit.
- Super Track: We have a dedicated 30 patient area which is staffed by attending Emergency Medicine Physicians and Advanced Care Providers, ED nurses and aides. This unit allows patients with minor illness or injuries to be treated rapidly.
- SkyHealth Transport Program: The Health System partnered with Yale New Haven Health System to operate an air medical transport program, SkyHealth. The program is based at North Shore University Hospital and is utilized by both health systems for inter-facility transports. The helicopter serves as an important vehicle to augment Northwell Health's mission for clinical excellence and regional expansion.
- Academics: Our staff engages in clinical research and education. We partner with the Hofstra Northwell School of Medicine. Southside offers a three-year ACGME-accredited Emergency Medicine Residency Program

About the Area:

Southside Hospital is located in a beautiful waterfront community on the south shore of Long Island in Bay Shore, New York. Bay Shore is one hour by train to Manhattan, and the area offers the choice of a rural, suburban or an urban lifestyle.
